

Fall Student Enrollment

Davidson's Fall 2005 enrollment of 1683 includes only full-time students. There were no part-time students enrolled. The 164 Davidson students on leave this semester are not included.

Federal enrollment accounting rules state that Davidson students studying away from campus in Davidson programs are counted in the reported enrollment number, while those in non-Davidson programs are not included. Similarly, non-Davidson students enrolled in Davidson programs are included in Davidson's enrollment figures.

Currently, there are 1842 students working toward a Davidson degree. This includes the 1653 Davidson students on-campus, the 25 Davidson students in off-campus Davidson programs and the 164 students on leave, whether for person/medical reasons or off-campus in non-Davidson programs of study.

Davidson continues to meet the goals of geographic diversity and equal enrollment by gender. The desired gender balance was achieved with the number of men and women differing by only 3. Geographically, Davidson enrolled students from 48 states (including District of Columbia) and 29 countries.

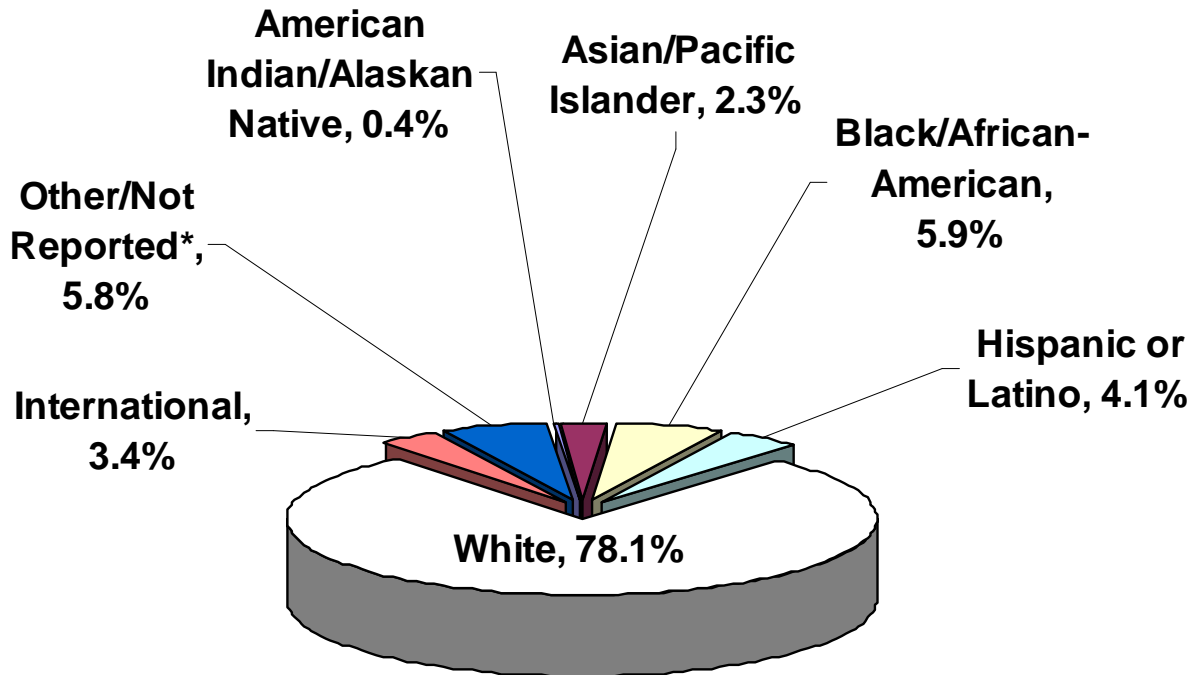
