



Office of Community Service and Bonner Scholars Programs

Major Programs

- **Bonner Scholars**—80 students involved with scholarship program. Students complete 10 hrs/week of service during academic year and 240 hrs for 2 of 3 summers. Portion of hours completed through curriculum focusing on content, skills and self awareness.
- **Freedom Schools**—Summer enrichment program for children in primary and secondary grades. 14 Davidson students serve as interns at 2 community sites. Davidson is the first college sponsored site / program.
- **Service / Community-based Learning & Research**—We work with faculty and community members to assist with curriculum development, site placements, assessment strategies, etc.
- **Community Service via Federal Workstudy**—20 students participate in community service for their FWS position. We serve as “site supervisors” and offer workshops and in-service training for these students.
- **Community Partnership Development**—We work with community partners to identify community issues and needs. These relationships are cultivated for site placements and to build resources for education sessions.
- **United Community Action (UCA)** - We advise this student-run organization that serves as an “umbrella governing body” for thematically organized service efforts on campus. Major projects include Alternative Breaks, Project Life, Habitat, Youth Programs.
