The Davidson Writing Center...

- offers assistance at any stage of the writing process, ranging from inventing and refining ideas, to organizing essays, improving stylistically, and addressing specific grammatical problems
- works with students through one-on-one tutorials or facilitates small group sessions for collaborative writing projects or peer critique
- provides trained peer tutors representing each major academic division: humanities, mathematics, and natural sciences/social sciences
- helps students solve specific writing concerns and improve their writing long-term.
