Greetings,

According to our records, we confirm that Davidson College is authorized as an institution, under provisions of North Carolina General Statutes (G.S.) Section 116-15 to conduct post-secondary degree activity in the State.

Subsection (c) of G.S. 116-15 provides in part that

Any institution that has been continuously conducting post-secondary degree activity in the State under the same publicly registered name or series of publicly registered names since July 1, 1972 shall be exempt from the provisions for licensure...upon presentation to the Board (of Governors of the University of North Carolina) of information acceptable to the Board to substantiate such post-secondary degree activity and public registration of the institution's names.

Davidson College has presented to the Board of Governors of the University of North Carolina information to substantiate exemption from licensure under G.S. 116-15 (c).

We trust that this confirmation will adequately evidence the eligibility of the institution for federal funds.
