



## Self-Selection Process 2003 Dates and Important Information

One of the exciting social and leadership options at Davidson College is the possibility of affiliating with a fraternity, or an eating-house. The process by which students make known their decision to join one of the above associations is called "self-selection." Please find below important dates and information concerning the self-selection process and how you can participate.

### Timeline for Men:

***On or prior to Reading Day*** - Male freshmen will receive self-selection forms from their Hall Counselors. Men should indicate if they wish to join a fraternity or co-ed eating-house, and if so, which one.

[Upperclass men may pick up a self-selection form from the Patterson Court Office (Residence Life Office in Belk Hall) or on the Patterson Court webpage].

***Tuesday, first week of Spring Semester*** - Self-Selection forms should be returned to your Hall Counselors by NOON. All forms must be returned, even if you choose not to affiliate with a Patterson Court organization. Hall Counselors and upperclass men will submit those forms to RLO by 5:00 p.m. ***Late forms will not be processed.***

***By Friday, first week of Spring Semester*** - Patterson Court staff will verify grades and distribute new member lists to fraternity presidents.

### Timeline for Women:

***On or prior to Reading Day*** - Female freshmen will receive self-selection forms from their Hall Counselors. Women should indicate if they wish to join an eating-house, and if so, which one.

[Upperclass women may pick up a self-selection form from the Patterson Court Office (Residence Life Office in Belk Hall) or on the Patterson Court webpage].

***Tuesday, first week of Spring Semester*** - Self-Selection forms should be returned to your Hall Counselors by NOON. All forms must be returned, even if you choose not to affiliate with a Patterson Court organization. Hall Counselors and upperclass women will submit those forms to RLO by 5:00 p.m. ***Late forms will not be processed.***

***By Friday, first week of Spring Semester*** - Patterson Court staff will verify grades and distribute new member lists to eating-house presidents.

### General Information:

Self-Selection results will be posted on Friday of the first week of the spring semester in the Patterson Court Office and on the Patterson Court webpage.

Students must have received at least a cumulative **2.00 GPA** to join a fraternity or an eating-house.

The new member period may not begin before the Friday of the first week of the spring semester and must end by the date published in advance by the Patterson Court Office. **NO exceptions will be given.**

Those who join an eating-house or become a social affiliate of a fraternity will become a full-organization member as soon as official membership lists are posted. Men who intend to become an inter/national member of a fraternity will become a full-organization member upon initiation into the inter/national organization.

All new members (fraternity and eating-house) are required to attend a new member orientation series in the spring semester.
