



Patterson Court Social Event Safety Standards

Developed by Pi Kappa Alpha, Beta Chapter on March 13, 1998
Adopted unanimously by the Patterson Court Council on April 23, 1998

In addition to the safety recommendations set out in *the Davidson College Alcohol Policy: Section V - Regulations for Events Sponsored by Recognized Student Organizations* from the Davidson College Red Book, the Patterson Court Council recognizes the following conditions necessary for prudent management of Patterson Court social gatherings:

1. The floor, stairs, and porch must be reasonably clean and free of slippery or dangerous substances.
2. Care must be exercised by the Risk Manager to discourage horseplay and dangerous behavior.
3. Members must be wary of those individuals who are overly intoxicated, and be prepared to point them out to the Risk Manager who should send such students home or inform the Police of their condition.
4. The Risk Manager must fully understand and follow his/her duties.
5. There must be Risk Management staff (IDers) at each entrance where individuals can gain access to the event.
6. No activity that shall endanger members or guests shall be sponsored by any Patterson Court organization.
7. The bar area will be clearly marked and separated to admit only guests twenty-one years of age or older.
8. All members will be required to follow suggestions and orders of Police Officers and Risk Managers.
9. There shall be a concerted effort by the host organization(s)' Executive Board to maintain contact and cooperation with all Davidson College authorities.
